SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 2018 REGISTRATION 9:30 A.M.

Relays start at 10 a.m., rain or shine. Targets will be at eight shooting stations, one shooter per station shooting four rounds per target, with a second re-entry/relay allowed and encouraged. BUT, before you shoot your second target relay, you must decide in advance which relay's target is to count for your overall score.

Scoring by the judges is final, with shoot-offs if necessary in case of a tie. There will also be a 50/50 shoot. All types of muzzleloaders and sights are permitted. Gather around afterward for a traditional outdoor lunch over the fire.

Two frozen turkeys will be awarded for the highest scores.
